Wildman Lake Lodge is a deluxe wilderness lodge facility located at the base of glacier-shrouded Mt. Veniaminof, on the banks of Ocean River, one of Alaska's finest clear water sport fishing streams. You will not find a more comfortable and finely appointed sport hunting lodge in all of Alaska. Wildman Lake Lodge is the perfect choice for corporate groups, hunting couples or the most discriminating trophy hunter. Lodge guests enjoy comfortable duplex cabins, each with a full bathroom and hot shower, baseboard heat and continuous electrical power. The lodge chef serves incredibly delicious meals in our spacious dining room. Big game hunts are conducted from comfortable tented spike camps where hunters are served whole foods and frozen meals prepared by our lodge chef. Special dehydrated meals are used only as back up. All of the food, supplies and camp gear are provided for your hunt. Clients need only bring their favorite rifle (30 caliber magnum or larger), ammunition, personal clothing, footwear and a good quality sleeping bag.



Our experienced bush pilots will fly each hunter and his guide from the main lodge to their own private spike camp to hunt for the trophy desired. All hunting is done Fair-Chase, from remote wilderness spike camps. Our camps are checked often by: radio, satellite telephone or one of the lodge's numerous bush aircraft. Each Wildman Lake Lodge hunting guide is a licensed professional, trained in First Aid and experienced in the situations that arise in the field such as: judging trophies, skinning, butchering and fleshing. The Wildman Lake Lodge guides will also see to the field care, fleshing and salting of your trophy as well as the other necessary duties in and around the spike camp.

Before January 1st, the year of the hunt, all deposits must be brought up to 50% as the final hunt confirmation. Deposits are then non-refundable, unless the vacancy is filled by the cancelling party at least 60 days before the hunt. Final Payment is due 60 days prior to arrival. Openings are limited, so book your hunt early!

Started on the Alaska Peninsula in 1971 as a young pilot and guide for Holen, who retired in 1983, Butch originally operated out of the Cinder River Lodge and later expanded into Wildman Lake Lodge in 1996. Now celebrating 45 accident free, safe & successful years.

#### **20 Years Sport Fishing -1996 to 2016**

Gary "Butch" and Kathy King purchased Wildman Lake Lodge, a rustic hunting camp, from retiring guide Keith Johnson. After a substantial reconstruction, the lodge opened that fall as a world-class sport fishing lodge.

### **Number ONE Alaska Brown Bear**

Once again, Wildman Lake Lodge has received the APHA/SCI award for the year's #1 Alaska Brown Bear. The First Place Alaska Brown Bear Award was

presented at the Alaska Professional Hunters Association banquet this past December to Wildman hunting client, Mark Robare, of Houston, Texas for this 10' - 8" Brown Bear taken the last spring season on the Alaska Peninsula. The huge Alaska Brown Bear scored 29-12/16 points SCI Mark took this enormous brownie in the Wildman Lake Lodge hunting concession,



with Gary "Butch" King, Master Guide-Outfitter, and assistant guide, Mark Anderson, on a spring hunt in May. During his long career as a guide and outfitter on the Alaska Peninsula, Gary "Butch" King's hunting clients have taken more than 138 ten foot and larger brown bear and have received the

### **Another 100% Season on Trophy Moose!**

his third rough ride of the afternoon. With still more flying to do, he taxied in and promptly tied down his super-cub, opting to wait for the black wall of weather to pass. The last hunter and guide were flown out just before dark, the eve of the 2015 Moose season at Wildman Lake Lodge.

What started with discouraging weather, ended up with several excellent hunting days during the 16 day season on the Alaska Peninsula, and another 100% season on trophy bulls
